Local Attractions

REDBANK CREEK

A true hidden gem of Western Pennsylvania, the Redbank Creek affords recreationalists kayaking and fishing opportunities. Creek access points are located near the Moore Rd. and Hawthorn Trailheads, just below the New Bethlehem Dam and at Hunters Moon Lodge.

If you prefer to stay dry, then spend time painting, photographing or watching birds along the shores of the creek.

MAHONING DAM

The Mahoning Dam is a concrete gravity dam that holds back the waters of the Mahoning Creek Lake. Built in 1941, it boasts the best dam tour next to Hoover Dam. Call 814-257-8811 at least 2 weeks in advance to arrange for private tours for groups of 10 or more.

REDBANK VALLEY MUNICIPAL PARK

Visit Redbank Valley Municipal Park 1.5 miles north of New Bethlehem & near the Trail, where the County Fair, Bluegrass Music Festival and ATV Poker Run are held. Camping sites available.

Redbank Valley Trails

Pennsylvania's 2014 Trail of the Year



Redbank Valley Trails are 51 miles of scenic, non-motorized trails that follow the old AVRR-low grade rail line from the Allegheny River to Brookville with a 9 mile spur from Lawsonham to Sligo. The trail follows and crosses the Redbank Creek and tributaries for 42 miles and connects to the Armstrong Trail, Erie to Pittsburgh and eventually the Great Allegheny Passage.

New Bethlehem is at the mid-point of this truly spectacular and scenic trail. Free parking is available in the municipal lot located in the center of town.



The trail provides 4-season non-motorized recreation for people of all ages with biking, hiking, running and cross country skiing. History surrounds the trail as noted by historic markers identifying the locations of many nature-based industries of the past.

While most of the trail is improved, some small sections and the Sligo Spur are still being improved. Please visit www.redbankvalleytrails.org or Facebook for current status and more information when planning your visit.
